Read the report and examine the appendices. Answer the following questions:

- a. Why are facilities and providers unable to prevent the improper claims that the RACs have identified in their reviews?
- b. What can providers and facilities learn from this report?
- c. What key points can be identified and then implemented at the coder, physician, and clinician level to improve reporting processes?
  - 1. Your initial post needs to be a minimum of 200 words posted by 11:59 PM on Thursday.
  - 2. The submission must answer all components of the prompt.
  - 3. The submission must include an internet or text citation including a URL in APA format.
  - 4. References are NOT to be included in the word count of at least 200 words.
  - 5. Submission must be completed prior to the deadline.
  - 6. You must respond to two (2) of your peer's posts with a submission of at least 100 words by 11:59 PM on Sunday.

- 7. The post reveals an understanding of the topic and is without spelling and grammatical errors.
- 8. You must use your own words to answer the prompt. A word-for-word response from an Internet site or textbook will result in no credit for the discussion assignment.
- 9. Do not restate a concept already posted by a peer.


