Summary/Intent	<p>20 to &gt;17 pts</p> <p>Advanced</p> <p>All annotations contain a 3rd person summary of the source as well as a first person direct statement of how the source will be integrated into the paper and its usefulness to the writing process. The required number of annotations are present, and they meet the required word count. Annotations meet the 150 word length requirement</p>	<p>17 to &gt;16 pts</p> <p>Proficient</p> <p>Annotations contain a 3rd person summary of the source, but do not include a first person statement of integration indicating its usefulness to the writing process. The required number of annotations are present, though the word count may be lower or higher than 150 words.</p>	<p>16 to &gt;0 pts</p> <p>Developing</p> <p>Annotations poorly reflect the source and statements of integration are missing, or the required number of annotations is not met, nor do the annotations meet the length requirements.</p>	<p>0 pts</p> <p>Not Present</p>	20 pts
